

# Llanishen Golf Club Local WINTER Rules

## Winter Rules Are In Operation Clean & Place On Fairway Only

### Preferred lies:

A ball lying on a closely-mown area through the green may be lifted without penalty and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, the player must place it on a spot within 6 inches of and not nearer the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard and not on the putting green. If you have to ask if your ball is on the fairway, then it's better to assume it's in the rough and play accordingly.

### Plugged ball through the green:

A ball embedded in its own pitchmark through the green (i.e. in the rough but Not in a bunker or water hazard) may be lifted, cleaned and dropped within one club length, no nearer the hole without penalty.

### White lines and ropes:

White lines must not be crossed with a trolley or buggy. Please walk around roped areas.

### Aeration holes:

If a ball is in an aeration hole it may be treated as G.U.R. and placed to one side when on the green or dropped through the green not nearer the hole. Relief cannot be taken simply because the hole is on line of play.

### Temporary greens:

When temporary greens are in play a ball resting on the main green **must** be lifted and dropped off the green not nearer the hole. Feet must be off the green. When temporary greens are not in play, and where they are marked with white lines, they are all to be treated as compulsory G.U.R. and balls resting on them must be lifted off.

### Trolley bans:

Please note that a trolley ban may be introduced at any time the head greenkeeper judges undue wear may occur.

### Greenkeepers works:

Deep ruts made by tractors are G.U.R. but not faint tyre impressions.

### Seeded & turfed areas:

Seeded, turfed or repaired areas are mandatory G.U.R. and relief must be taken at nearest point of relief not nearer hole.

### Construction works:

All construction works are G.U.R.

### Definition of fairway:

If players can't determine the edge of the fairway, please liaise with your playing partners. Use common sense.

### **PLEASE OBSERVE THE ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME AT ALL TIMES**

**SLOW PLAY:** Always play in a sprightly manner. If you are not keeping your position on the course allow the group behind to play through.

**REPAIRS:** Ensure that divot, pitch and bunker marks are properly repaired.
